Termite damage is not covered under the average home insurance policy.

Brief Facts on Termites

Termites look similar to ants. Between the months of October and March, termite colonies regularly release thousands of flying termites referred to as alates into the air to find a suitable new colony. They may be mistaken as flying ants.

Termites rarely expose themselves to light and can actually die from direct sunlight exposure.

Termites work 24 hours a day.

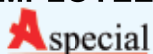
A typically infested home may have three to four subterranean termite colonies around it, with as many as 1 million termites in each colony.

Termite queens can live up to 15- 25 years and are capable of laying hundreds of eggs each day

Subterranean worker termites forage up to 50 -70 meters from the colony in search of wood-based food sources.

Rodent proof your home this autumn

As the weather cools down towards autumn, the rats and mice are on the hunt for warmth and food in most homes. The first action against rodent's infestation is to reduce the risk of infestation by making your home a less attractive place for them to stay.



Rodents cause billions of dollars damage in Perth every year, causing damage to wiring, floor boards, wall and even your home's insulation. In addition, some rodents are also carriers of human diseases such as Salmonella, Poliomyelitis, Mouse typhoid and other potential health concerns.

So what can we do to reduce rodent's infestation risk this autumn?

- Seal all food in plastic or metal containers.
- Do not leave any excess food unsealed such as pet bowls.
- Store boxes off the floor and organise items often to avoid rodents from residing in undisturbed areas.
- Keep household garbage in closed bins.
- Check that all drain pipes are clear and channel water away from your home.
- Seal all exterior cracks and holes including areas where pipes enter.
- If you find rodent's faeces, scratching sounds in the walls or other signs of infestation, contact a licensed pest control professional to inspect and treat your rodent problem effectively.

Many DIY rat control remedies may work but the results are often less than satisfactory which may cause small rodent problems to develop into larger ones. Young rat can squeeze through a hole of the size of 10 cents coin and a mouse, through a much smaller diameter such as a pencil thus obtaining a professional help will result in a more effective eradication than a DIY procedure.

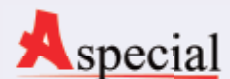
Allpest's rat radio advertisement "We Don't Negotiate with Rats," has picked up a Bronze at the 2011 New York Festivals Advertising Awards.
